

Quick-Start Guide: How to transfer documents to my iPad using GoodReader?



This tutorial is intended to be a quick-start guide to help you “get started” using more Web 2.0 technology.

#1: Launch the GoodReader APP.

#2: Click the “Wi-Fi Transfer” icon.

#3: The “Wi-Fi Transfer” dialogue box appears.

#4: Launch your browser or open a new tab/window in your existing browser.

#5: Copy the iPad IP-address into your browser address bar.

#6: This will establish a wireless connection with your iPad. You will now be able to download documents to your iPad from your computer.

#7: Click “Downloads”.

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iPad Connection

Although you can upload files with web-browser, it's not the best way of doing it. It works with one file at a time and it doesn't let you move / rename / delete files or folders. To have full control over the process (to transfer whole directories, rename and delete files, etc.) you have to connect your device as a network folder. Visit www.goodreader.com for instructions.

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#9: This will open to your computer's file directory.

#8: Click "Choose File".

#10: Select "My Documents", select a file (document) that you want to transfer (upload) to your iPad, and then click "Open".

Look in: My Documents

File name: ABPD & TAPS

Open as read-only

#11: The name of the file you want to upload will appear next to "Choose File".

#12: Click "Upload Selected File".

#13: The uploaded file will appear in your iPad Directory.
